## **GRADUATION ELIGIBILITY**

1. Student must have been homeschooled his/her entire senior year. (Parents are considered principal/teacher by state law.)
2. At least 50% of student's schooling was supervised at home by a parent or legal guardian.
3. Student cannot have been enrolled in any school during the 2020-2021 school year, with the exception of the dual enrollment program at TCC or any other participating college.
4. Student and one parent must attend the three 2021 **Mandatory meetings**
  - 1) **November 19<sup>th</sup>, or February 18<sup>th</sup> - Orientation**
  - 2) **May 6<sup>th</sup> - Final Detail Wrap Up**
  - 3) **June 4<sup>th</sup> - Rehearsal**
5. Student must submit application, notarized affidavit, graduation fee, and order forms by attended **November 19<sup>th</sup>, or February 18<sup>th</sup> orientation deadline**, in addition, photos and Bios are due by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
6. Student must behave in a respectful manner at all meetings, rehearsal and graduation ceremony. T.E.A.C.H. reserves the right to prohibit participation in Graduation if any behavior or dress is deemed inappropriate.
7. Outstanding debts to TEACH / BEACH must be met before eligibility is granted to attend the graduation.
